




He'll always be prepared


Cuckoo for Cocomats

These new Cocomats feature a hardy ribbed rubber backing designed not only to last but to catch debris and to keep the mats from sliding around underfoot. Custom-fit Cocomats are available for many new cars, trucks and SUVs and come in 13 color combinations, including black-andred dots, black herringbone and black-and-taupe dots. Custom-fit Cocomats come in two-, three- and fourpiece sets, plus cargo and truck mats. Prices range from \$129.95 to \$249.95. This limited-edition fragrance, the latest installment in Mugler's Angel series, is easily the most unusual men's cologne launched in a while. While the name obviously gives away the starring scent, it's anything but a one-note wonder. Think of it as a fast-moving olfactory slide show with espresso quickly morphing into bitter chocolate that all at once is transformed into an aged leather pouch holding fine pipe tobacco. That's the complex set of scents Pure Coffee brings to mind, not a basic cup of java. Coffee, musk, patchouli, cedar wood and vetiver all go into Pure Coffee. It comes in a container as off-beat as the scent it contains. The coffee-bean-colored soft-sided bottle comes emblazoned with an offset raised gold star on the front. Draw drafts at home

If you want to ensure that your dad's the coolest guy in his circle, then consider getting him the Krups Beer Tender, which allows Dad and his pals to enjoy an authentic draft beer experience at home. This handsome black-and-chrome unit holds a 5-liter keg of Heineken beer. Note that it's designed to be used only with the Heineken keg. The Beer Tender is simple to use. Just open the lid, drop in the keg, attach the tube and snap the lid shut and it's ready to dispense icy cold beer that can be chilled to 36, 39 or 42 degrees. The LCD screen not only displays the temperature, but it shows volume and counts down from the date the keg was installed. The Beer-Tender will keep the beer fresh for up to 30 days — assuming the beer will actually last that long. The cooling system is virtually silent but won't work outdoors in the heat, so to keep the brew cold, use the Beer Tender indoors. It comes with a removable drip tray that makes cleanup hassle free. The Beer-Tender sells for \$299 and is available at most Bed Bath & Beyond stores or through www.amazon.com.
